Crucifixion

Islam teaching

The Qur'an says Jesus was not killed or crucified as believed; God raised him.

Call My G reading

Prophecy, Gospel witnesses, and apostolic testimony make crucifixion and resurrection central facts.

Scripture Trail

Psalms 22; Isaiah 53; Matthew 27-28; 1 Corinthians 15:1-8

KJV passages and notes

Read the cited KJV passages in context. The listed witnesses identify the trail; the cumulative conclusion must be tested across all of them.

Sin and salvation

Islam teaching

People bear their own deeds, repent directly to God, and depend upon mercy; a divine atonement is rejected.

Call My G reading

Individual accountability is real, while Christ's sacrifice makes redemption possible.

Scripture Trail

Ezekiel 18:20-23; Isaiah 53:5-6; Romans 3:23-26; 1 Peter 3:18

Satan and fall

Islam teaching

Iblis refused God's command concerning Adam and became humanity's tempter.

Call My G reading

Satan's first-age rebellion drew a third of the stars and made this flesh age necessary.

Scripture Trail

Isaiah 14:12-15; Ezekiel 28:12-19; Revelation 12:4,7-9

KJV passages and notes

Read the cited KJV passages in context. The listed witnesses identify the trail; the cumulative conclusion must be tested across all of them.

Return and judgment

Islam teaching

Islam expects resurrection and judgment; many traditions also expect Jesus and a false messiah.

Call My G reading

The false christ appears before Jesus returns at the Seventh Trump and begins the Lord's Day.

Scripture Trail

Matthew 24:23-31; 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4; Revelation 11:15; 20:1-15

KJV passages and notes

Read the cited KJV passages in context. The listed witnesses identify the trail; the cumulative conclusion must be tested across all of them.
