Scripture Trail

Mark 7:6-13; Acts 17:11; 2 Timothy 3:15-17

KJV passage and note

ISAIAH 8:20 - KJV: To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them. NOTE: Every inherited system remains answerable to the written testimony.

The gospel and the larger plan

Nondenominational Evangelical teaching

The center is personal salvation through Christ, conversion, growth, and heaven after death.

Call My G reading

Salvation is central, while three earth ages explain origin, flesh, coming deception, and reconciliation.

Scripture Trail

John 3:16; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4; Job 38:4-7

KJV passage and note

JOB 38:4, 7 - KJV: Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth?... When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? NOTE: Identifying these witnesses as God's children before flesh belongs to the cumulative synthesis.

Genesis and identity

Nondenominational Evangelical teaching

Genesis 2 usually develops Genesis 1, and individual identity begins at conception.

Call My G reading

Sixth-day humanity and Eth-ha-Adam are distinct; God's children existed before flesh.

Scripture Trail

Genesis 1:26-31; Genesis 2:5-25; Romans 8:29-30

KJV passage and note

JOB 38:4, 7 - KJV: Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth?... When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? NOTE: Identifying these witnesses as God's children before flesh belongs to the cumulative synthesis.

Rapture assumptions

Nondenominational Evangelical teaching

Independent churches hold several incompatible end-times systems, often without naming their historical source.

Call My G reading

The gathering follows revelation of the false one, and Christ returns at the last Trump.

Scripture Trail

Matthew 24:23-31; 2 Thessalonians 2:1-4; 1 Corinthians 15:52

KJV passage and note

2 THESSALONIANS 2:1, 3 - KJV: ...by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him... that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed. NOTE: Paul places the counterfeit revelation before our gathering.

Pastoral authority

Nondenominational Evangelical teaching

Local teachers may exercise great influence without external doctrinal oversight.

Call My G reading

Teachers open the trail; the student remains responsible to test reasoning and distinguish conclusion from statement.

Scripture Trail

Ezekiel 34:2-4; Acts 17:11; 1 John 4:1

KJV passage and note

ISAIAH 8:20 - KJV: To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them. NOTE: Every inherited system remains answerable to the written testimony.

Questions for an informed insider

1. What theological family trained the pastors and produced the study materials?
2. Does having no denomination eliminate tradition or hide it?
3. Which conclusions came from a chart?
4. Who may reopen a settled local doctrine?
