Scripture alone is infallible; confessions guide the church by summarizing its system.

A confession can clarify reasoning but must remain open when the biblical trail reopens it.

Isaiah 8:20; Mark 7:6-13; Acts 17:11

[KJV passage and note](#)

ISAIAH 8:20 - KJV: To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them. NOTE: Every inherited system remains answerable to the written testimony.

Election

[Reformed / Presbyterian teaching](#)

God freely chose some to life, not because of foreseen faith, works, or any condition in them.

[Call My G reading](#)

The called and justified were known before flesh; election reflects former-age standing, not arbitrary favoritism.

[Scripture Trail](#)

Jeremiah 1:5; Romans 8:29-30; Romans 9:11-13

[KJV passage and note](#)

JOB 38:4, 7 - KJV: Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth?... When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? NOTE: Identifying these witnesses as God's children before flesh belongs to the cumulative synthesis.

Human freedom

Reformed / Presbyterian teaching

After the fall, a person cannot convert himself; saving freedom is restored by grace.

Call My G reading

Flesh weakens knowledge without erasing choice; circumstances remain proportionate and the test genuine.

Scripture Trail

Deuteronomy 30:19; Joshua 24:15; 1 Corinthians 10:13

KJV passage and note

1 CORINTHIANS 10:12-13 - KJV: Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall... [God] will with the temptation also make a way to escape. NOTE: Dependence upon grace and meaningful accountability remain together.

Origin and covenant

Reformed / Presbyterian teaching

The person begins in this life, and covenant theology organizes the story from Adam's fall.

Call My G reading

The story begins in the first earth age; Genesis distinguishes sixth-day humanity and Eth-ha-Adam.

Scripture Trail

Genesis 1-2; Job 38:4-7; Revelation 12:4

KJV passage and note

JOB 38:4, 7 - KJV: Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth?... When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? NOTE: Identifying these witnesses as God's children before flesh belongs to the cumulative synthesis.

Millennium

Reformed / Presbyterian teaching

Many Reformed churches read the thousand years as Christ's present reign, though views vary.

Call My G reading

Revelation orders a future Lord's Day: Satan bound, priests serving, release, test, and judgment.

Scripture Trail

Revelation 11:15; Revelation 20:1-15; 2 Peter 3:8

KJV passage and note

REVELATION 20:6-7 - KJV: ...they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years. And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed. NOTE: The priestly work and final release must be included in the sequence.

Questions for an informed insider

1. Why was Jacob loved before birth if he had no personal history?
2. Does foreknowledge describe information or people God knew?
3. How is accountability preserved if every choice is decreed?
4. What is lost when Revelation 20 becomes the present church age?

Fairness and claim status
